What is our Mission?

“To provide youth temporary shelter and necessary supports to be safe, limit academic disruption, receive medical care, and have meaningful engagement in their community while practicing skills and abilities to promote long-term independence and autonomy and develop healthy relationships with a community support system and achieve permanency.”

- On-site counseling
- 24/7 supervision and safety
- Self-esteem development
- Life skills training
- Linkage to community services
- Permanency housing and security
- Family Counseling
- Limited school disruption

TO MAKE A REFERRAL:

- Contact Mountain Haven and request the referral and intake/assessment forms. Complete and return the forms as soon as possible.
- DCBS: social worker will need to be present and sign release for services and provide required documentation (medical insurance card, birth certificate, social security card, immunization record, commitment order, case conference plan, psychological/psychiatric evaluations, level of care form, DPP-144 and medical consent, DPP-886A and DPP 886, medical passport).
- If you are not committed, a parent/guardian shall be notified within 72 hours in order to secure permission and participate in initial intake and assessment.
- If the initial assessment indicates need, youth will be taken for immediate medical and/or behavioral health evaluation.
